Mark your calendars. This is the most important meeting we have each year. We need you or your proxy to attend this meeting. Our Community has five Board Member positions. Walter Kamphoefner's and Dustin Vaughn's terms are up and another position is open, which has been vacant since February. Let us know if you are interested in running or who you would like to run by early January so you/they can be placed on the ballot. Anyone can be nominated at the meeting, but without proxies to back up that nomination, it is unlikely they will muster sufficient votes to win.

Shortly before the Meeting your Block Captain or a Board Member will bring by a Proxy for you to sign. Even if you plan to attend, go ahead and sign the Proxy. Then, if you do attend the meeting, your Proxy will be returned to you. Quorum needed for meeting is 49 votes. At our last Annual Meeting (1/14/2010), Five Members attended with 8 votes plus 59 Proxies who reelected Mark Coppock and elected his wife, Nancy Coppock.

In 2009, 13 attended with 13 votes plus 64 proxies. In 2008, 17 attended with 16 votes plus 108 proxies. In 2007, 11 attended with 15 votes plus 40 proxies.

Home Work: For those who want to get free labor for projects around their house, A&M students will provide it, for one day only, to the first 1000 who ask. They will do yard work, brush trimming, hauling, and planting, and will do exterior cleaning and painting, etc. They have been doing this since 1982 to show their gratitude to the towns that they call home. They are not allowed to use power tools, but muscle driven tools, with many provided by A&M, are used. Last year 11,000 A&M students volunteered.

Park Work: The board is looking for a volunteer or two, who will contact Big Event and oversee any of following work, their pick: 1. Scrape, sand, prime, and paint painted areas. 2. Seal raw wood areas. 3. Remove grass from volley ball court and gravel play ground area. 4. Trim low hanging limbs from trees. 5. Trim back limbs from picnic areas on the hill. 6. Trim grass along curb. 7. Plus anything else the volunteers want done. Board will provide materials and any tools the Big Event will need.
