

ORDINANCE NO. 1867

**AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF GABBARD ROAD EXTENDING FOR APPROXIMATELY 1,890 FEET BETWEEN HARVEY MITCHELL PARKWAY (F.M. 2818) AND NORTH TRADITIONS DRIVE, TO NORTH TRADITIONS DRIVE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETINGS AT WHICH THIS ORDINANCE WAS PASSED WERE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Bryan, Texas is a home rule city with the specific general powers of such under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of City of Bryan, Texas is of the opinion that the best interest and welfare of the public will be served by changing the name of Gabbard Road to North Traditions Drive;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRYAN:

1.

That the name of the street known as Gabbard Road, being approximately 1,890 feet in length from its intersection with Harvey Mitchell Parkway (F.M. 2818) to its intersection with North Traditions Drive, as depicted on attached Exhibit "A", shall be changed to North Traditions Drive.

2.

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

3.

That should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional, or invalid for any reason, the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected thereby, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance and declared to be severable.

4.

That it is hereby found and determined that the meetings at which this ordinance was passed were open to the public, as required by Section 551.001, et seq., Texas Government Code, and that advance public notice of time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given.

5.


This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its second and final reading and passage.

PRESENTED AND GIVEN first reading the 27<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2010 at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Bryan, Texas; and given second reading, PASSED AND APPROVED on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2010 by a vote of 6 yeases and 2 noes at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Bryan, Texas.


